DES Reform 2017 Budget Announcement

- During the next four years, the Australian Government will invest more than \$3 billion in DES and associated services.
- This includes more than \$300 million over the next ten years to index payments to DES.
- To take effect from 1 July 2018



DES Reform - Consultation

- Significant consultation with the provider and disability sectors.
- This has helped shape the changes being introduced.
- Two major changes:
 - Increased participant choice and control
 - Relaxing market restrictions increasing competition and contestability.



DES Program Changes – Participant Choice and Control

- Easier for participants to choose their own employment provider and how services are delivered.
- Funding follows the participant should they move provider.
- Empowering a person in selecting their pathway to employment.




Improving Competition and Contestability Between Providers

- Current market share arrangements for DES providers will be removed.
- DES providers will now have to attract job seekers to their organisation, rather than being guaranteed a share of available business.



Improving Competition and Contestability Between Providers

- Easier for existing DES
 providers to expand their
 services into new regions,
 and for new organisations to
 join DES and become a DES
 provider.
- Improved competition and contestability between providers will drive innovation.



Registrations of Interest are open!

- Registration closes 29 August.
- Existing providers that register interest and are performing well will get an 'Invitation to Treat'.
- Current and potential new providers can also <u>apply</u> to provide DES services.
- Applications will be open for six weeks in September and October
